Command words are the words and phrases used in exams and other assessment tasks that tell students how they should answer the question.

The following command words are taken from Ofqual's official list of command words and their meanings that are relevant to this subject. In addition, where necessary, we have included our own command words and their meanings to complement Ofqual's list.

Analyse	Explain
Interpret data to arrive at a conclusion.	Set out purposes or reasons.
Calculate	Give
Work out the value of something.	Produce an answer from recall or from given information.
Comment	Identify
Present an informed opinion.	Name or otherwise characterise.
Compare	Justify
Identify similarities and/or differences.	Support a case with evidence.
Complete	Label
Finish a task by adding to given information.	Provide appropriate names on a diagram.
Deduce	List
Draw conclusions from information provided.	List a number of features or points without further elaboration.
Define	Name
Specify meaning.	Identify using a recognised technical term.
Describe	Outline
Set out characteristics.	Set out main characteristics.
Design	Predict
Set out how something will be done.	Give a plausible outcome.
Determine	Show
Use given data or information to obtain an answer.	Provide structured evidence to reach a conclusion.
Draw	Sketch
Produce a diagram.	Draw approximately.
Estimate	State
Assign an approximate value.	Express in clear terms.
Evaluate	Suggest
	Dresset a nassible same/askutian
